Instructions:

IT Project Managers:

Your project has suffered a loss of a key team member, resource, or found a critical design flaw. You will need to address the unplanned event as an effort to keep your project on track. You will have a status meeting and produce a status report. In addition, reflect upon your project and write at least a two-page paper in APA style discussing any ethical, legal and/or social issues that have could arise once your project/project goes live into a production environment.

IT Specialists:

You will continue the implementation of your project following the IT Project Plan you created in Unit 2. In addition, reflect upon your project and write at least a two-page paper in APA style discussing any ethical, legal and/or social issues that have could arise once your project/project goes live into a production environment.

Assignment Requirements:

IT Project Managers:

Part 1

Produce a project status report, updated WBS, and conduct a project status meeting with key stakeholders to present options and make a decision on how to mitigate the event. Note that if a virtual (mock) project was selected, then would be a mock status meeting.

- Meeting Minutes
- Agenda
- Accomplishments
- Description of Unplanned Event
- Solution to the Unplanned Event
- WBS Reflecting Work Completed to Date
- Milestones Completed to Date
- Revised/Actual Budget to Date

Also, include an issues log/register as part of the status report:

- Issue/Item
- Strategy
- Date Logged
- Date Resolved

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Note: In addition, any impact to the project plan and/or deliverables should be reflected within the status report and WBS.

Submit the recap, status report, and updated WBS as one document (note that the WBS may also be submitted as a separate .mpp file).

Part 2:

Write at least a two-page APA style paper (excluding title page and references page) discussing any ethical, legal and/or social issues that have could arise once your project/project goes live into a production environment.

IT Specialists:

Part 1:

Prepare a report that outlines the tasks completed in milestone 2 of your project. Evidence will be presented that milestone 2 was completed as defined in the IT project plan.

Part 2:

Write at least a two-page APA style paper (excluding title page and references page) discussing any ethical, legal and/or social issues that have could arise once your project/project goes live into a production environment.
